



CURBSIDE LANDSCAPE WASTE COLLECTION PROGRAM

The Village offers this service as a courtesy. No bill will be sent for the service. It is free of charge for Village residents.

The Village's landscape waste collection program allows residents to place paper yard waste bags filled **ONLY** with dry landscape waste at the curb for pick-up on the second and fourth Wednesdays of the month during the months of April thru October. From November to March of each year, landscape waste will be picked up once a month on the second Wednesday. Landscape waste bags must be 30 gallon, double-sided, paper bags specially designed to hold landscape waste. No boxes or plastic bags will be picked up.

Dry landscape waste includes branches, shrubs, vines, tree trimmings and other similar items generated by the maintenance of lawns and gardens. This **DOES NOT** include grass clippings or leaves.

****Tree trimmings/branches should have a diameter no larger than 6". Any trimmings with a diameter larger than 6" WILL NOT be picked up. Any landscape waste or trees professionally removed or trimmed WILL NOT be picked up. In that instance, the waste becomes the responsibility of the tree company and/or the homeowner.**

COLLECTION & PREPARATION

- Dry landscape waste bags must be placed out at the curb by 7 a.m. on pick up days.
- Sticks/branches must be neatly placed parallel to the curb.

PLEASE NOTE:

- WET/TORN BAGS OR BAGS CONTAINING OTHER THAN DRY LANDSCAPE WASTE **WILL NOT** BE PICKED UP.
- STICKS/BRANCHES NOT PLACED PARALLEL TO THE CURB **WILL NOT** BE PICKED UP.

Landscape waste bags may be purchased locally at the Village Hall on Broadway St. for \$2.75 per bundle or at any home improvement store.
